Citizen Corps Council Objectives:

The objectives of this citizen advisory group are to promote and strengthen the Citizen Corps program, develop targeted outreach for the community, organize special projects and community events, and encourage cooperation and collaboration among community leaders.

Term Length

Two years

Meeting Schedule

Citizen Corps Council will meet four times a year (February, May, August, November). Times and location may vary.

Attendance

Missing two or more meetings during a calendar year will result in termination from the council.

Membership

Citizen Corps Council members are appointed by the Mayor and cannot delegate their responsibilities to other persons. Council members are asked to serve without compensation.

Community sectors represented on the Citizen Corps Council include:

Business/Industry, Civic Organizations, Community-Based, Education, Faith-Based, Government, Labor Organizations, Media, Medical, Neighborhood Organizations, Nonprofit, Senior Citizens, Technology, Tourism, Transportation, Utilities, Veterans, and Youth.

A minimum of 2 representatives from each sector will serve on the Citizen Corps Council at all times. If a sector has less than 2 representatives, the Mayor and/or selection committee will appoint a new member.
